PVC Care Instructions

Care and Cleaning:

Each week, remove dirt and smudges with a non-abrasive soft, damp cloth and towel dry. In very rainy weather, cover or remove cushions since seams can trap and absorb moisture. Cushions should be stored in a dry, well-ventilated place. The use of Vinyl "Conditioners" or "Protectants" is not recommended and should be avoided on all Fabtex PVC products.

Special Cleaning Problems:

To minimise any problems from stains, it is recommended that as soon as they are noticed all stains should be cleaned, as some stains can become permanent if not removed quickly.

Use mild soap and water solution and if necessary, a very soft bristle brush. Rinse with clean water and towel dry.

Non-abrasive All-purpose cleaner or 20% conc. alcohol could be applied for stubborn stains. Rinse cleaned area with clean water then dry with a clean and lint free cloth. Use caution in cleaning around buttons, stitching and wooded or decorative trim, since these solvents could seriously damage such areas.

Do not use under any circumstances:

- hard sponges like pot cleaners or hard brushes
- dry cleaning agents, cleaning foams or sprays
- cleaning petrol
- aggressive and bleaching household cleaners containing chlorine
- solvent agent containing cleaners (paintbrush cleaners or nail polish removers)
- hairspray

The above items are not recommended for vinyl cleaning purpose as they will damage the surface layer of the vinyl.

CAUTION: Suntan lotion and insect repellents can cause rapid staining and deterioration of the surface of the product. Remove these products immediately after contact.
